How to earn your badge...

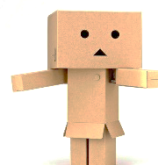
1. Design a model of something you would like to build. The design can be on paper or a computer.

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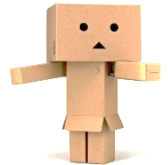
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
