Overview

One very popular FairTrade product are Bananas, so I've added a quick fun activity for the kids to do using a banana.

Materials Needed For Each Team

- 1 Banana
- Two sets of wheels and axles
- Felt Pen
- A ramp for each team



Directions/Leader Speak

1. Write a number on the banana
2. Stick the axles through each end of the banana and attach the wheels
3. Now put let's say 4-6 Banana Cars at the top of a ramp and let go and see who gets to the bottom first
4. You should be able to get hold of the wheels with axles for about a 70p-£1 if your budget doesn't allow this for everyone then just buy let's say 6 sets and get each team to take it in turns
