1. Print the endangered species animal pictures in this document you need ne animal for each child. There are 7 different animals so some children will have the same

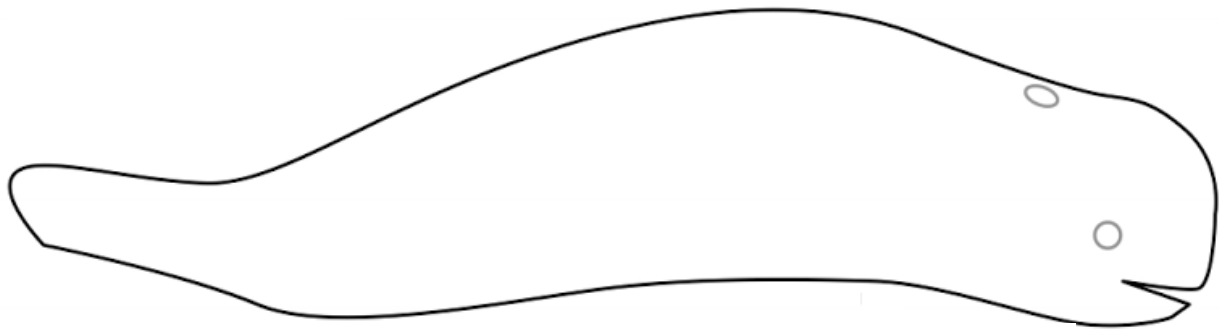
Materials Needed

3. **Directions** - Give each child an animal to colour in cut out and fasten or glue together.



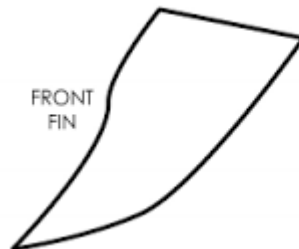

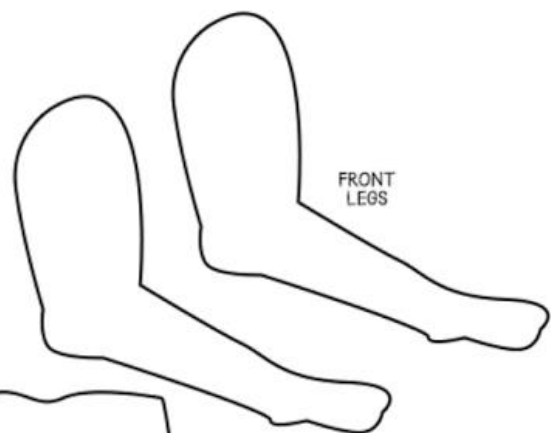

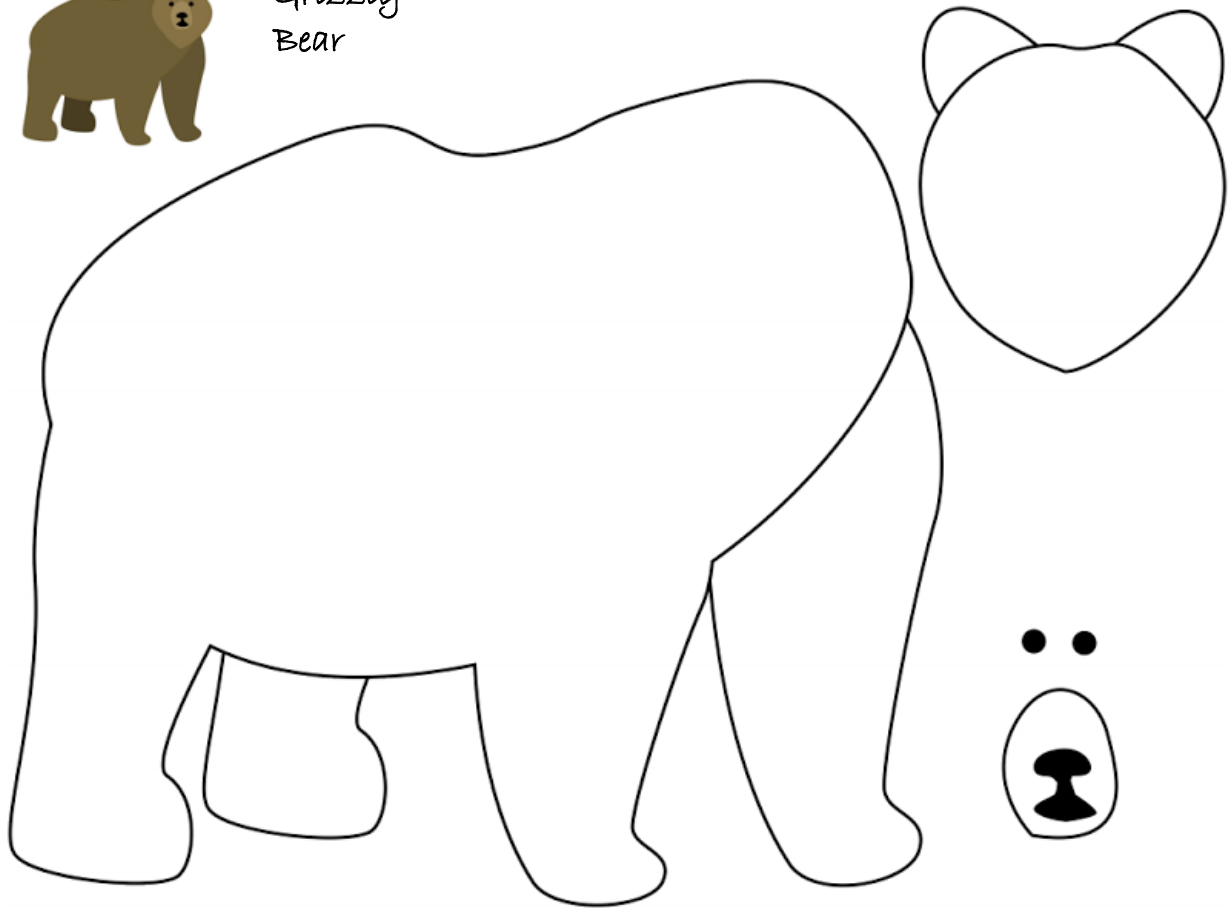

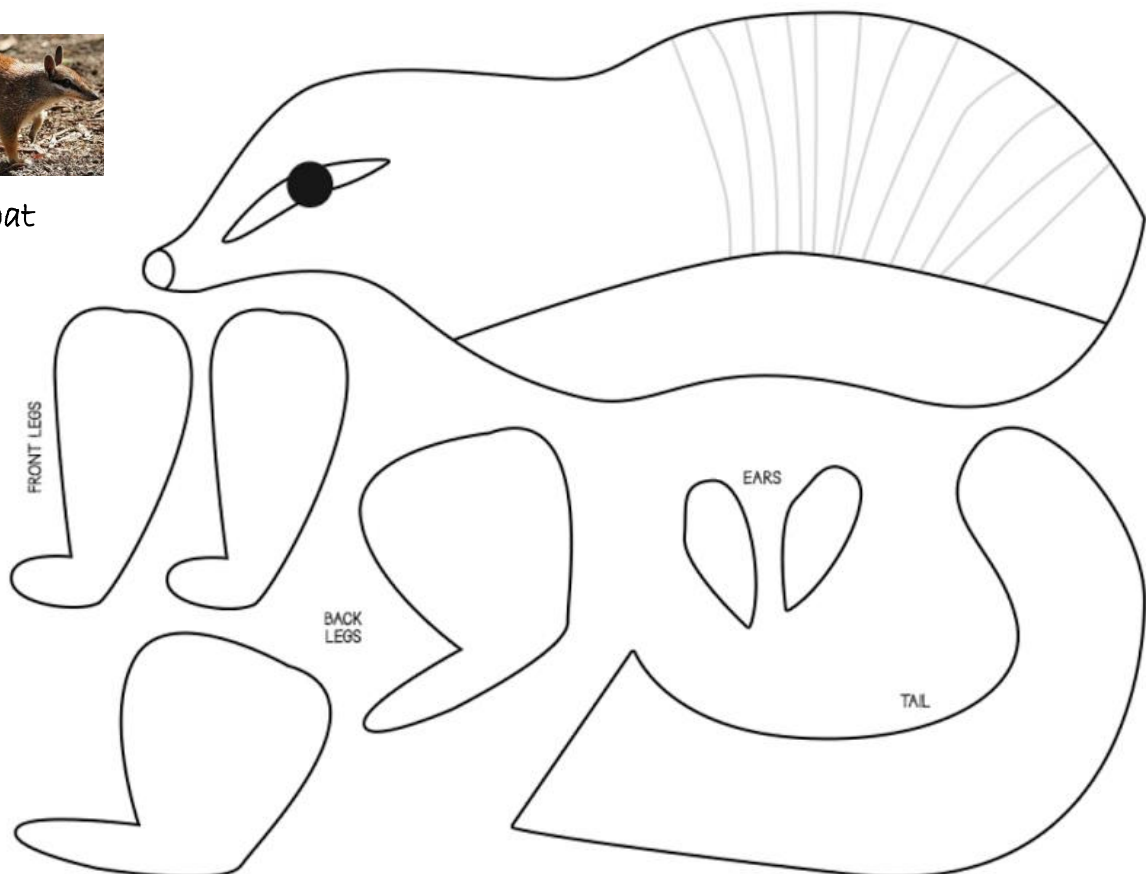

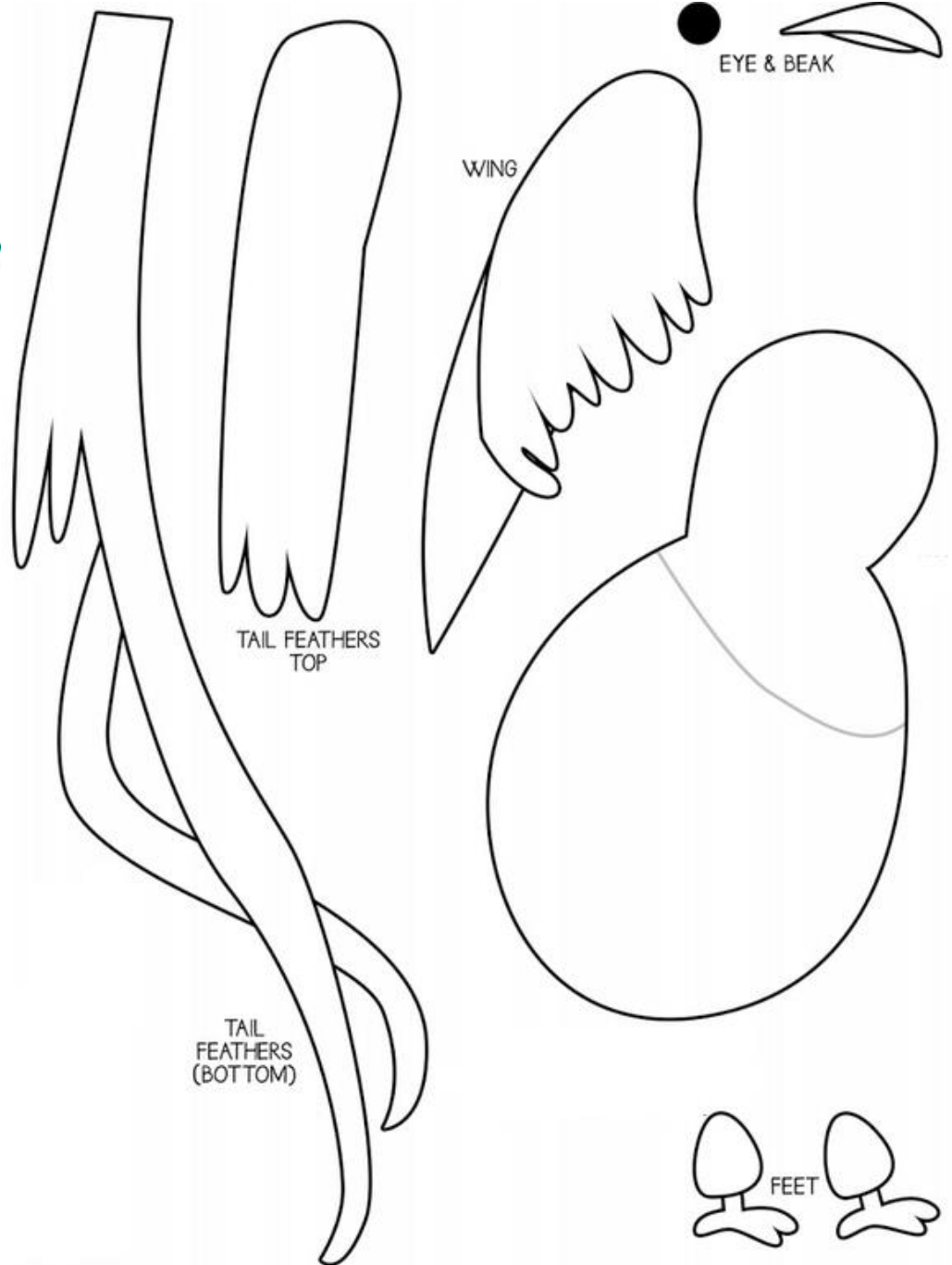

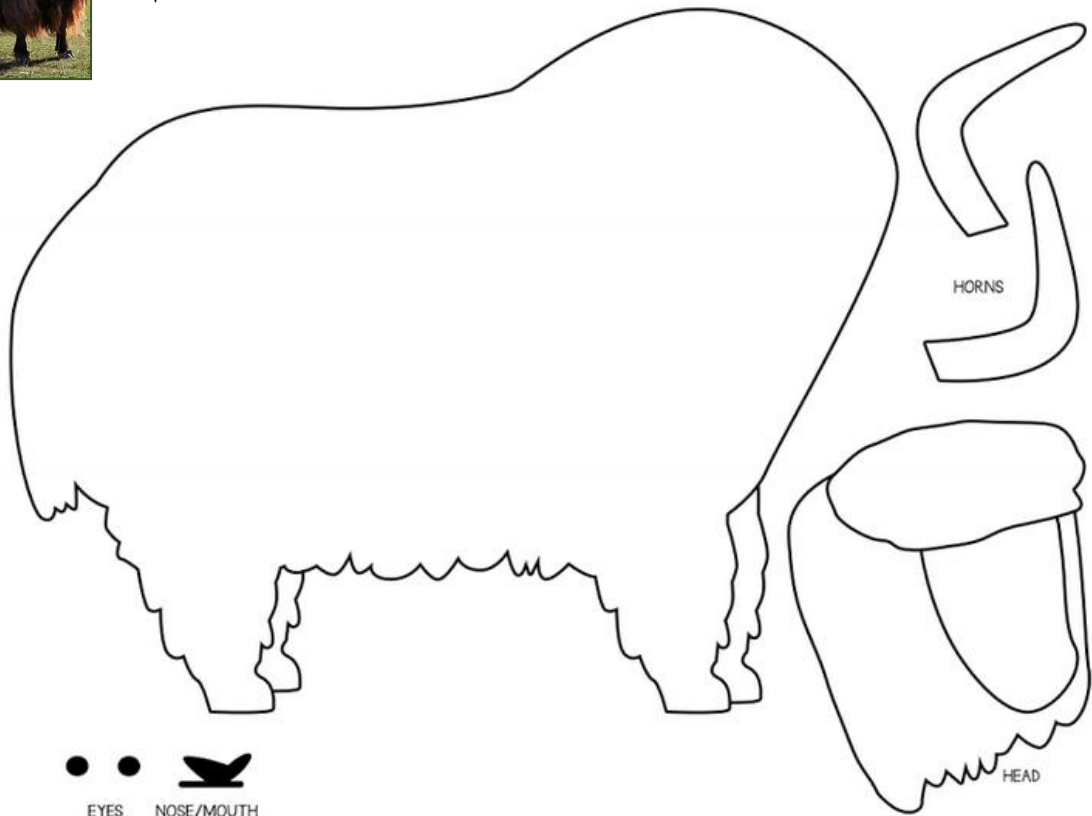
