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My Adventure Challenge Award

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Overview

For this part of the outside activities the children will have fun with mud and nature bits by making some mud creations.

Preparation Before The Meeting

1. A week before you are due to do this activity ask the children to come in some old clothes and warn the parents that they might come home a little muddy
2. Print out the example pictures of the mud people – found in this document you just need a couple of copies to hand round to the children to give them some ideas

Materials Needed

- Some bottles of water (this will be used to pour on the mud if it's too dry)
- All other materials will be found whilst the children are outside
- Camera

Directions/Leader Speak

1. **Speak** - The next activity you are going to carry out for your 'My Adventure Challenge Award' is to make some mud creations
2. **Speak** - We are going to go outside and build some creations using mud and other nature bits. Here's some pictures of the sort of creations you could make
3. **Action** - Take some water with you in case you need to dampen the mud
4. **Action** - Take pictures of the kids creations and make a collage to put on the wall in your meeting place
