Overview

For this task the children will do a quick matching activity to learn what to do if their friend has an accident. Then they will perform some simple first aid procedures using the ‘Task 4 document of the Emergency Aid Stage 1 Badge’ named - 04-Cuts, Scratches and Grazes

Preparation Before The Night

1. Print out the ‘Matching Activity’ – found in this document - you need one for each team of two

Directions/Leader Speak

1. **Speak** - For the next task in your ‘My Outdoors Challenge’ badge you need to know what to do if someone has an accident, why it’s important to tell someone and how to help let’s say your friend if they cut their knee.
2. **Speak** - The most important thing to remember about first aid is that you have to keep yourself safe. Always look out for danger and send for help as soon as possible
3. **Speak** - Just being there for your friend will make them feel better and you will be able to say what has happened when an adult or the ambulance people come along.....and that will be very helpful
4. **Speak** - I’m going to give you some text and pictures and in teams of two I want you to cut out the squares then match the correct picture with the text that you think it should go with. Also order them in the order you think it should go to help your friend if they have an accident
5. **Direction** – Now to teach the children practical first aid skills go to the ‘Task 4 document of the Emergency Aid Stage 1 Badge’.
