Overview

For this task Beavers will learn a song as they go on a quest to help a dog named Brownie. Brownie faces three different challenges and the beavers will help him conquer the odds through a motivational song.

The song also aims to give them the value of compassion and kindness to pets by showing the kids how adorable dogs are. Additionally, the song will also help kids realise the risks of being in high elevated areas and the importance of being safe and cautious.

Preparation Before The Meeting

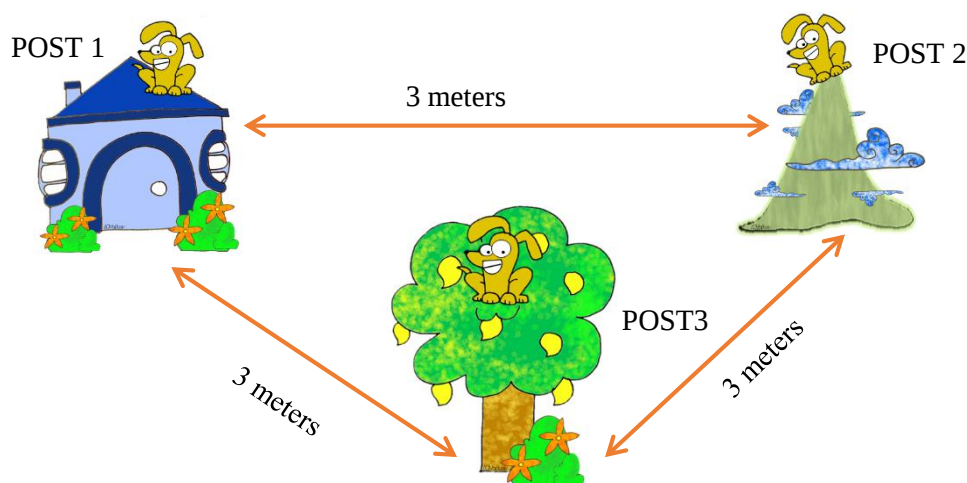
1. Print out the three ‘Saving Brownie Scenes’ – found at the end of this document

Materials Needed

- Printed Pictures of scenes from Saving Brownie
- Tape and White board/Flip Chart

Preparation At The Meeting

1. Write the lyrics of the song on a white board so the kids can easily read and memorise them
2. The activity intends to make the beavers move around the room. Set the pictures on three different spots inside the room, ideally 3 meters apart.



Directions/Leader Speak

1. **Speak** - The next task you need to complete for your 'My Skills Challenge Award' is to learn a new song and sing it
2. **Speak** - We've created a fun song called 'Saving Brownie' it has three verses. Each verse will be used to save Brownie the dog from a dangerous situation. I am going to sing the song in the tune of "**Row, Row, Row your Boat**" and I want you to follow me line by line
3. **Action** – The leader should start to sing the song...(in your best voice!)

For POST 1 – Verse 1

Climb down from the **roof**
'cause you might slip and fall
Slowly brownie, slowly brownie
Climb down from the roof

For POST 2 – Verse 2

Climb down from the **hill**
'cause you might slip and fall
Slowly brownie, slowly brownie
Climb down from the hill

For POST 3 – Verse 3

Climb down from the **tree**
'cause you might slip and fall
Slowly brownie, slowly brownie
Climb down from the tree

4. **Action** – The leader can accompany the song with actions such as hand gestures of someone climbing down
5. **Direction** - After learning the song, announce the mission to the beavers

Beavers, someone needs your help. A dog named Brownie faces dangerous situations in elevated places. He might fall down and get bruised. Help him climb down and be safe by singing the right song to him.

6. **Direction** - To start the mission, ask all the children to stand on SPOT 1 and perform this skit:

Leader: Hey beavers, are you ready to save brownie?

Beavers: Sir/Miss, yes sir/miss!

Leader: Oh look, Brownie is in danger. Can you tell me where he is?

Beavers: On the roof.

Leader: Oh no! Brownie should get down safely. Let us cheer him up with a song. Ready, sing!

Beavers: (To sing the first verse)

7. **Direction** - After SPOT 1, they can move to SPOT 2 and perform this skit:

Leader: Hey beavers, are you ready to save brownie?

Beavers: Sir/Miss, yes sir/miss!

Leader: Oh look, Brownie is in danger. Can you tell me where he is?

Beavers: On the hill.

Leader: Oh no! Brownie should get down safely. Let us cheer him up with a song. Ready, sing!

Beavers: (To sing the second verse)

8. **Direction** - After SPOT 2, they shall move to SPOT 3 and perform this skit:

Leader: Hey beavers, are you ready to save brownie?

Beavers: Sir/Miss, yes sir/miss!

Leader: Oh look, Brownie is in danger. Can you tell me where he is?

Beavers: On the tree.

Leader: Oh no! Brownie should get down safely. Let us cheer him up with a song. Ready, sing!

Beavers: (To sing the third verse)

9. **Speak** - Hey beavers, good job! You saved brownie? Now altogether, let us sing the whole song. Ready, sing!

10. **Action** - They now sing the whole song together
