Overview

A kid named Vic left his Book of Clothings at the library. Without it, Vic won’t be able to wear appropriate clothes. For this task the children will be given two missions one to get through to the library to retrieve Vic’s book and the second to retrieve the correct clothing for Vic to wear.

Preparation Before The Meeting

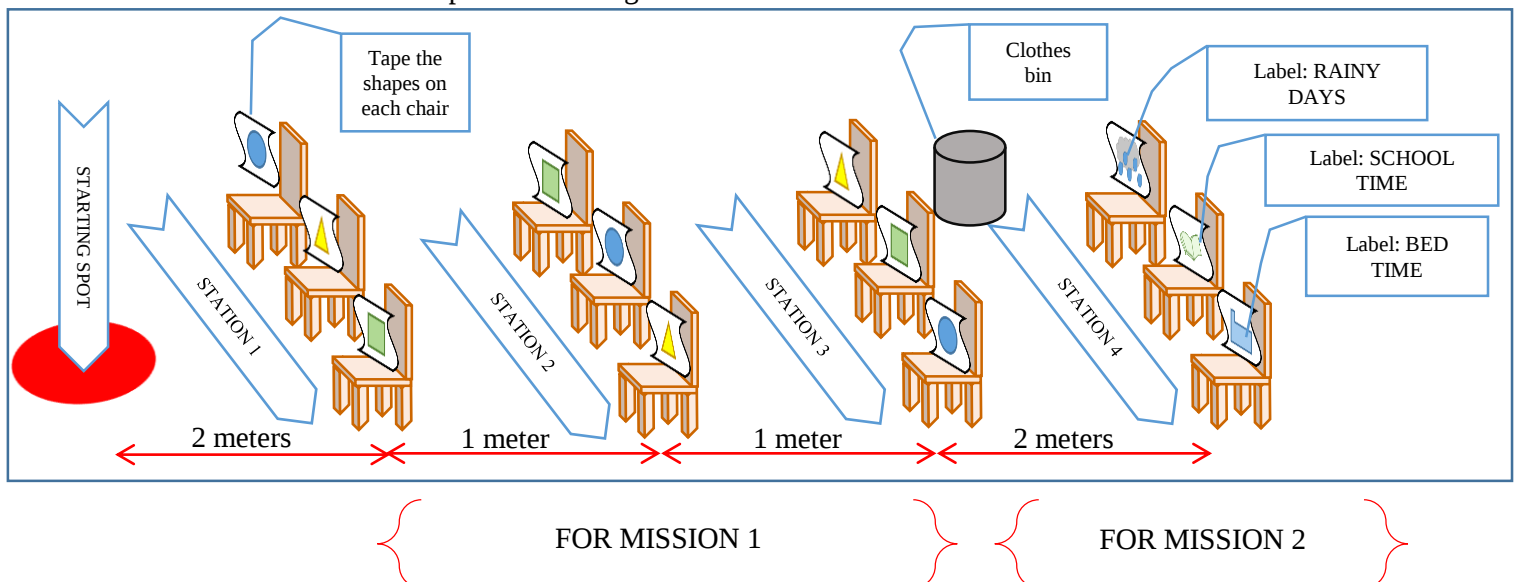
1. Print out the ‘Clothing Pictures’ – found at the end of this document – you need 1 copy of each piece of clothing. Cut them out and put them in a container with wide opening for easy access
2. Print out the ‘Shape Pictures’ found at the end of this document – you need 3 of each shape

Materials Needed

- Printed pictures
- 12 Chairs (3 chairs per station)
- Tape
- Small Bin with wide opening
- Paper
- Markers

Preparation At The Meeting

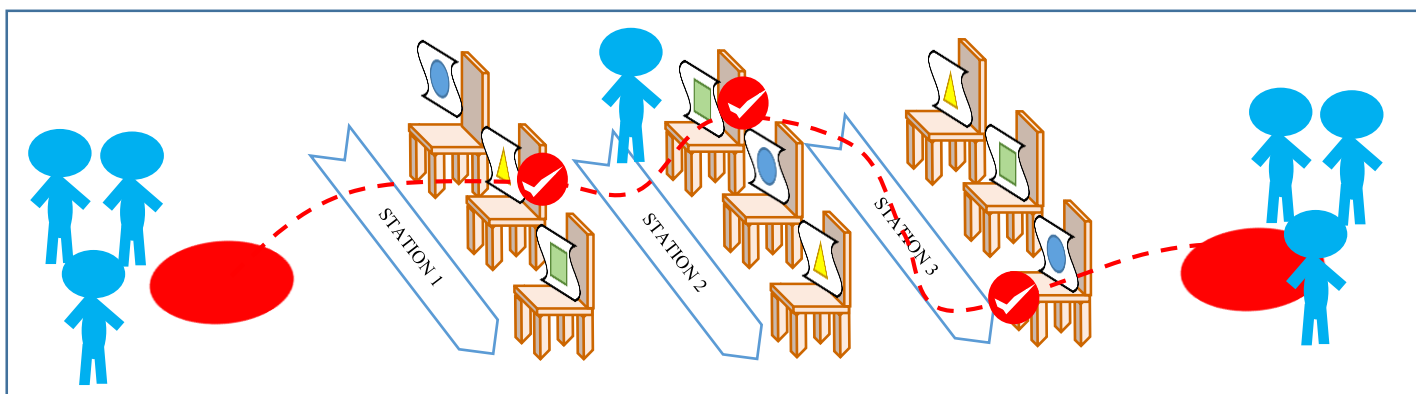
1. Follow this room plan and arrange the stations in the room



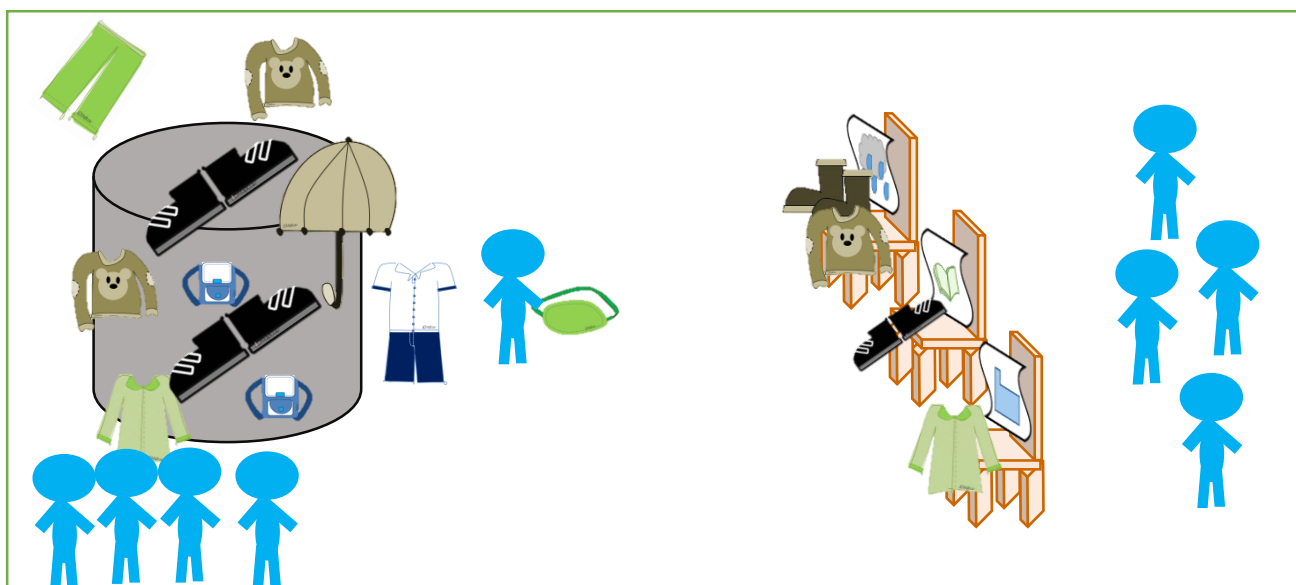
Directions/Leader Speak

Note. The first mission is not necessarily about shapes so don’t worry if you think the shapes are too easy it’s more about memory of the shapes.

1. **Speak** - The next task you need to complete for your 'My Skills Challenge Badge' is to accomplish two missions
2. **Speak** - I want everyone to come to this 'Starting Spot'
3. **Speak** - Vic needs your help to retrieve his book from the library so he can wear appropriate clothes for the day. Your first mission is to get inside the library by passing through three doors with shape marks: first, the one with **triangle**, second, the one with **square**, and lastly, the one with **circle**. You will pass through the doors one by one. And while you are passing everyone else must face the other way. You need to remember the proper order of the doors. I am only going to say it one more time - **Triangle, Square, Circle**. Good luck!
4. **Speak** - Once you have reached the library you can immediately start Mission 2. You are now inside the library and you found Vic's clothing book. However, it seems like all the clothes in the book are mixed-up. Your Mission 2 is to arrange the clothes accordingly depending on occasion: **rainy days, school days, and sleeping time**. You have to go to this bin and pick the correct clothes for each occasion and place them on the book pages located on each chair. Good luck!
5. **Direction** - While a child is passing through the doors the other children should face the other way. If a beaver passes through the wrong door, he should return to the end of the line and have another go once the other children have gone through



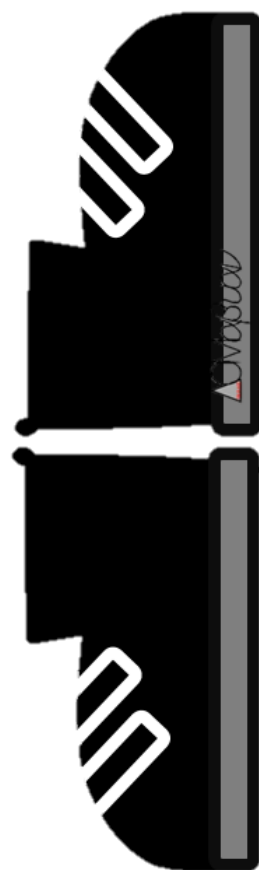
6. **Direction** - When a child has successfully passed Mission 1, they can go straight onto Mission 2. But you will need two leaders one keeping an eye on the order at which they pass through the doors for mission one and one to keep an eye on mission 2
7. **Speak** - Brilliant you've all accomplished two missions well done.



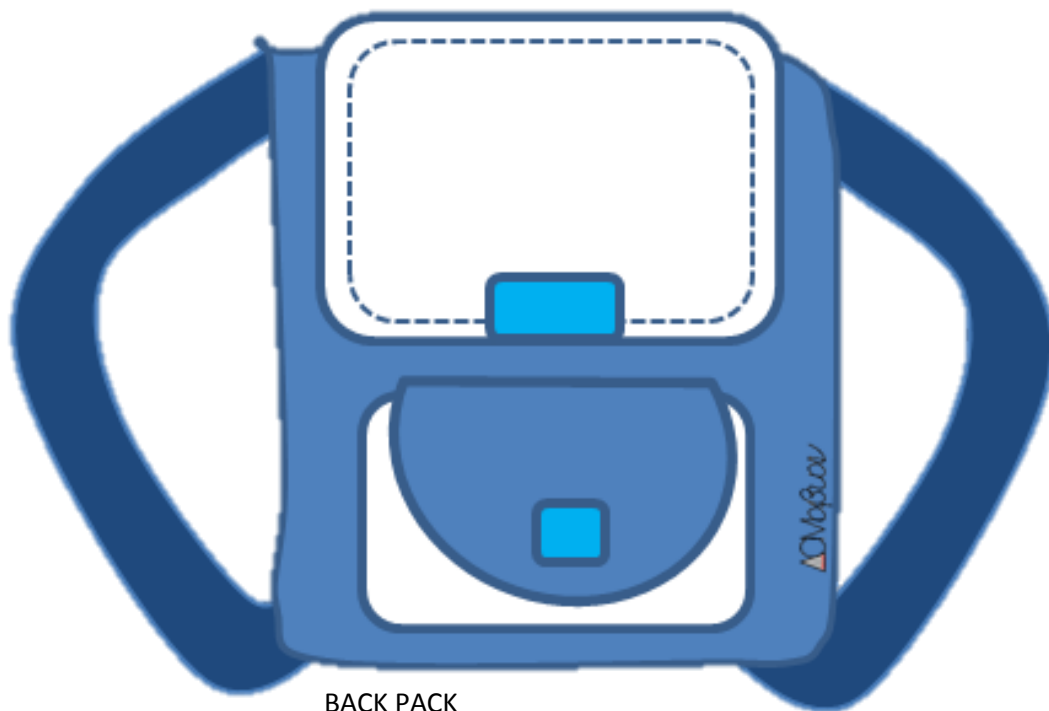
