Overview & Timings

There are **six main** tasks the children need to carry out to complete the 'Teamwork Challenge Award' for Beavers. Below I have outlined roughly what I have created for your children to gain this badge.

Tasks 1 & 3 Take Part In At Least Four Different Team Games

Show Your Leader That You Are A Helpful Team Member

In this document you will find four different team games. These games are very easy to run and will give the kids a night of giggles and fun.

Task 2 Work With Other Beaver Scouts To Make Something Or Complete A Challenge Or Activity Together

For this task the children will build a 'Balloon Jet Car' in teams of four. Once all teams are finished they can race their cars.

The children will be given a brief overview of what a 'Log Chew' is. Then they will take part in their first one.

The children will play a game that will teach them the meaning of foe as a friend. By playing this game they will discover the joy of friendship and encouragement.

Order Of Events
