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Overview

For this task the children will create a Super Hero in teams of three. Each child will draw part of it without the other members knowing what they've drawn. All will be revealed at the end!

Preparation Before The Meeting

1. None

Materials Needed

- A4 sheets of paper at least 6 for each team of 3
- Pencil and some coloured felt pens

Preparation At The Meeting

1. Layout the materials for each team

Directions/Leader Speak

1. **Speak** - The last task you need to do for your 'Creative Badge' is to use your imagination. So tonight you are going to get into teams of 3 and create a 'Super Hero' between you
2. **Speak** - I am going to give you a piece of A4 paper and the first person in the team has to draw the 'Head and Neck' of their super hero without the other two team members seeing. Use your colours to make it more creative and draw it at the top of the paper. When you are done fold down the top of the page to leave just the edge of the neck visible and pass it to your team member
3. **Speak** - Now team member two draws the body and arms of the Super Hero. When this part is finished, again fold your paper leaving just the bottom of the middle visible
4. **Speak** - Now team member three draws the legs and shoes
5. **Speak** - Once the picture is finished in your teams unfold the entire picture to reveal your teams Super Hero
6. **Action** - Get all the children to look at each others, it should be quite funny.
7. You can then swap the teams around and either draw another Super Hero or stay with the same teams but this time draw a monster or an animal
8. Each person has 2 minutes to draw their part
