- Pen

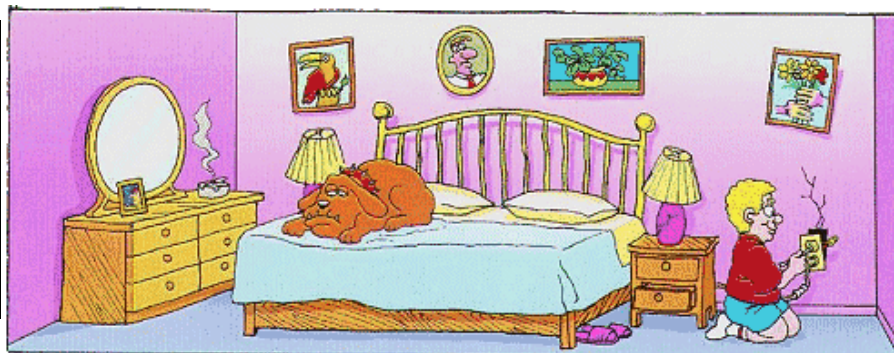
Directions/Leader Speak

1. **Speak** - The next task you need to do for your ‘Safety badge’ is learn how to spot potential dangers around your house
2. **Action** - Split your group into teams of two
3. **Speak** - I’m going to give each team a handout and I want you to look at the pictures and identify what you think may be dangerous in each room – When you have decided tick the box that matches the danger
4. **Direction** - Each leader will need to go around to each team to help them if they are struggling
