Preparation At The Meeting

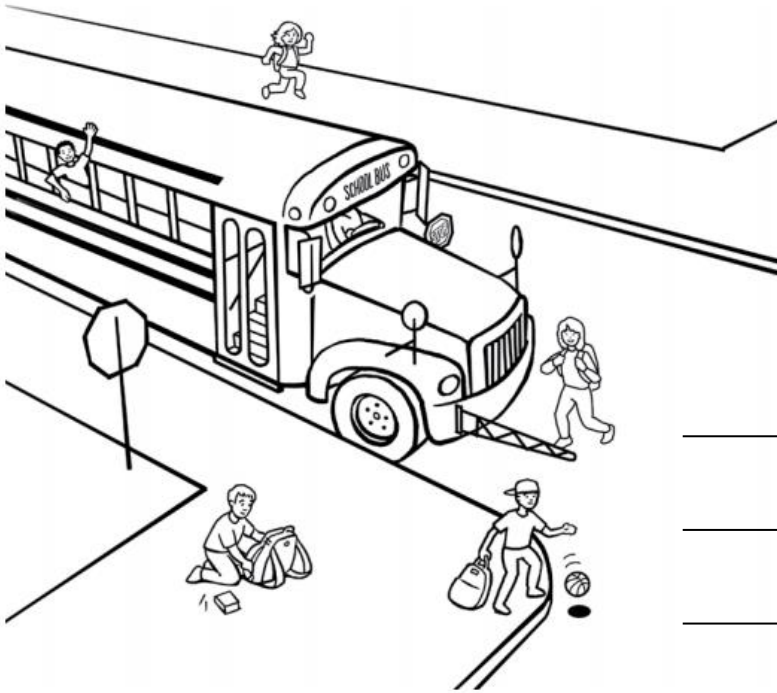

Directions/Leader Speak

1. **Speak** - The next task you need to complete for your 'Safety badge' is to know what to do at a roadside. You are going to do a couple of activities for this
2. **Action** – Split your group into teams of two
3. **Action** - Hand out the 'School Bus Safety' handout to each team of two
4. **Ask the following four questions to the children allow one of them to answer you.** Praise them give your answer and ask them to write it down on the handout
 - Ques 1. What do you think is wrong with the girl running near the bus
 - Ans. The girl should not be running she should be walking
 - Ques 2. What's wrong with the boy waving out of the window
 - Ans. He should be sitting on a seat
 - Ques 3. What's wrong with the girl in front of the bus
 - Ans. The girl should not be in front of the bus because the driver can't see her
 - Ques 4. What's wrong with the boy with the ball
 - He shouldn't be playing with the ball near the street or be so close to the edge
