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Beavers International Badge

Overview & Timings

There are **five main** tasks the children need to carry out to complete the 'International Badge'. Below I have outlined roughly what I have created for your children to gain this badge.

Task 1 Learn A Song, Play A Game Or Perform A Dance From Another Country

For this task the Beavers will play a game that is commonly played in the Philippines. They'll also learn a bit about the country before they do.

Task 2 Find out About Beaver Scouts, Or Younger Scouts If They Don't Have Beaver Scouts, In Another Country. What Do They Call Themselves? What's Their Uniform Like? And What Do They Say For Their Promise? Find Out As Much As You Can

For this task the Beavers will in teams do a little fun activity where they will be given information on Beavers Scouts in 7 different countries. In teams they have to complete the correct information for each country.

Task 3 Draw Five Different Flags From Five Different Countries Across The World. Tell Someone Else A Fact About Each Country

For this task the Beavers will get into teams of two and build a collage which will include the country's flag and other information about that country.
