Overview

The idea of the game is to get **all** the children from their group to the lab first before it blows up!

Prepare a part of the room as the labs. Explain to the children that there is something in their lab that is going to blow up in 3 Minutes and they need to get all their professors into the lab to stop it. (Maybe you could have some treats waiting in their lab). The only way to get to the lab is to answer some simple questions.

Preparation Before The Evening

1. Print out the cards found on the next page you need a set for each team of four (There are 3 sets on one page to save paper)

Instructions For The Game

1. Split the children into their groups of four at the opposite end of the room to where the labs are
2. Mix up each set of cards keeping the sets separate
3. Place a set of cards face down near each team
4. On your count get the children to try to match the cards
5. Assign a leader/parent to each team so they can check the answers
6. If they match everything correctly they can all run to their lab before it blows
7. Don't forget to time this.
