Overview & Timings

There are **four main** tasks the Beavers need to carry out to complete the 'Money Skills Badge'. Below I have outlined roughly what I've created for them to gain this badge.

Task 1 Show That You Know The Values Of Different Coins And Notes, Then Design One Of Your Own.

For this task your group will do a couple of fun activities. The first one will be to learn about the coins and notes that are in circulation and their value. Then they will use their coins and notes to buy some items from your shop.

File name: 01-Money and Shops

Task 2 Choose Something To Save And Keep Track Of How Much (Or How Many) You Have

For this task your group will record the money they have received this year and record in a simple sheet.

Task 3 Show How You Make Decisions Between What You Want, What You Need, And What You Donate Or Share

For this task your group will do an activity that will get them thinking about things they can donate or share. Or things that are a necessity or that they want.

Task 4 Choose A Creative Way To Explain The History Of Money And The Different Ways We Can Spend Money Today

For this task your group will briefly learn how money has evolved. And then they will play a game called 'The Barter Game'.
