Choose Something To Save And Keep Track Of How Much (Or How Many) You Have

Money I Received This Year!®

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Overview

For this task your group will record the money they have received this year and record in a simple sheet.

Preparation Before The Meeting

1. Print out the 'Money I Received This Year' table – you need one for each team and there are two on the page

Materials Needed

- Pen or Pencil for each person
- Printed money used in Task 1 of this planner

Preparation At The Meeting

1. Share out the money evenly to each team – They should have £85 in notes and £3.88 in coins so basically one of each

Directions/Leader Speak

1. **Speak** - The next task you need to complete your 'Money Badge' is to keep track of how much money you have

There are very good ways to do this now. For example, you can use a computer program, a spreadsheet, and most banks have really good apps to do this for you.
2. **Speak** - Today we are going to do this using paper but when you get home if you have a computer that you use with your parents you can record it in there
3. **Speak** - Now the money I gave each team earlier has a total amount. What I want you to do is to fill in the table I am going to give you so that you can record what you have. You are going to pretend that you have received some pocket money and birthday in different amounts and record it on the sheet.
4. **Speak** - I want you to fill out the amount column in teams using the money you have until it all runs out. For example, in January you could put the amount for your 'Pocket Money' as £3 so you would put £3 to one side because that has been used. Then in February you could write £50 that you received for your Birthday then put that £50 to the side and so on.
5. **Speak** - When you have finished recording all the money you have put a total at the bottom so you know how much you have this year.
6. **Direction** – You may need to help them
