Overview

For this task your group will start to learn a little about different aircraft by playing a game called 'The Super Flyers Game'.

Preparation Before The Meeting

1. Print out the pictures of the aircraft – found in this document – you need one set
2. Print out a copy of the 'Direction Questions' & 'Bonus Point Questions' – found in this document – you need one for the leader

Materials Needed

- 3 pieces of A4 paper and a pencil

Preparation At The Meeting

1. Randomly stick the 'Aeroplane Pictures' on the floor but spaced out around the room (you need quite a bit of space between them because the entire group will at some stage stand near each one)

Directions/Leader Speak

1. **Speak** - The next task you need to do for your 'Air Activities Stage 1 badge' is to find out about a kind of aircraft and tell others about it. It could be a passenger aircraft or a military aircraft.
2. **Speak** - What we are going to do for this is play a game called the 'Super Flyers Game'. To become a 'Super Flyer' your team have to earn the most points
3. **Direction** - Split your group into teams of 4
4. **Speak** - I'm going to give you all a direction for example, "You are travelling on Concorde today" - your team have to then find where 'Concorde' is in the room and stand near it. Each team will gain 1 point if they are standing near the correct aircraft but the first team to get to that aircraft will gain 2 points
5. **Speak** - In between finding an aircraft I am going to randomly ask your team a question (use the bonus point questions) or you may have to draw something - If you get this correct your team will gain a bonus point
6. **Direction** - Award a tiny prize for the winners if you wish

Direction Questions...

Image Reference to help identify the aircraft	The leader will say the following to the group...
Image 1	Today you are travelling on ' Concord '. This was a powered supersonic passenger jet airliner that was operated until 2003. It had a maximum speed over twice the speed of sound
Image 2	Today you are travelling on one of the most famous fighter aircrafts the ' Spitfire '
Image 3	Today you are going to London/Scotland (depending on where you are based) in a ' Helicopter '
Image 4	Today you are going on holiday on an ' Airbus A380 '
Image 5	Today you are going on holiday on a ' Boeing 777-300 '
Image 6	Today you are flying in a military aircraft called the ' Lynx Helicopter '
Image 7	You won a competition so today you are going to ' Disneyland Paris ' with your friends in a Bombardier CRJ-200 Regional Jet
Image 8	Today you are going on a military aircraft called the ' Panavia Tornado '. This is a Multirole Combat Aircraft, Used By The RAF
Image 9	Today you are learning to fly in a ' Piper PA-38 Tomahawk '. This is a two-seater plane

Please note you can repeat the aircraft text above to see if they have remembered them from the first time you read them out.
