### Overview

1. Layout materials

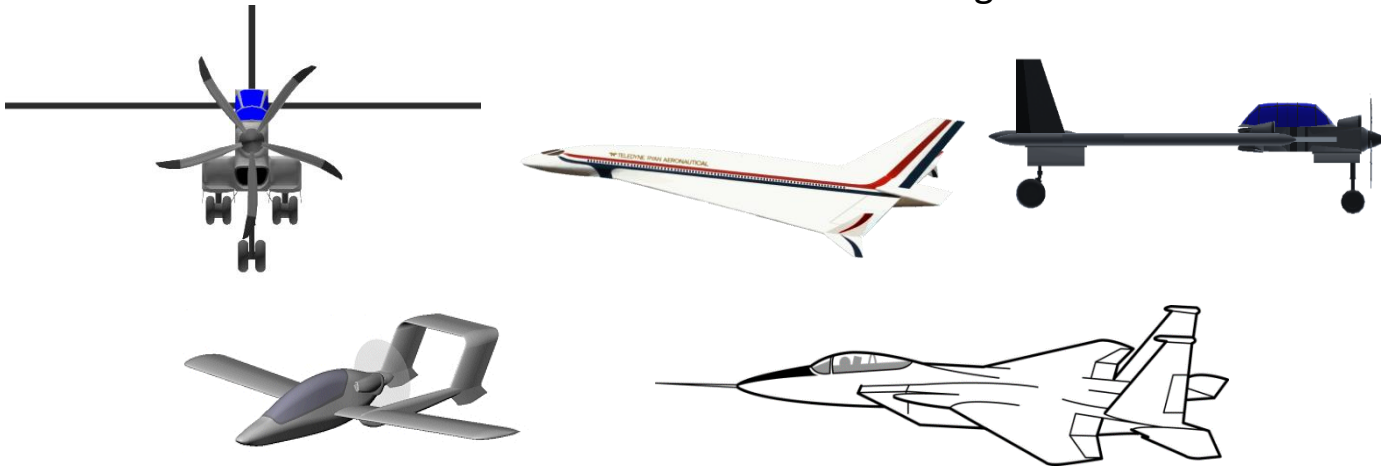
### Directions/Leader Speak

4. **Action** - Hand out the 'Aircraft Designs' handout

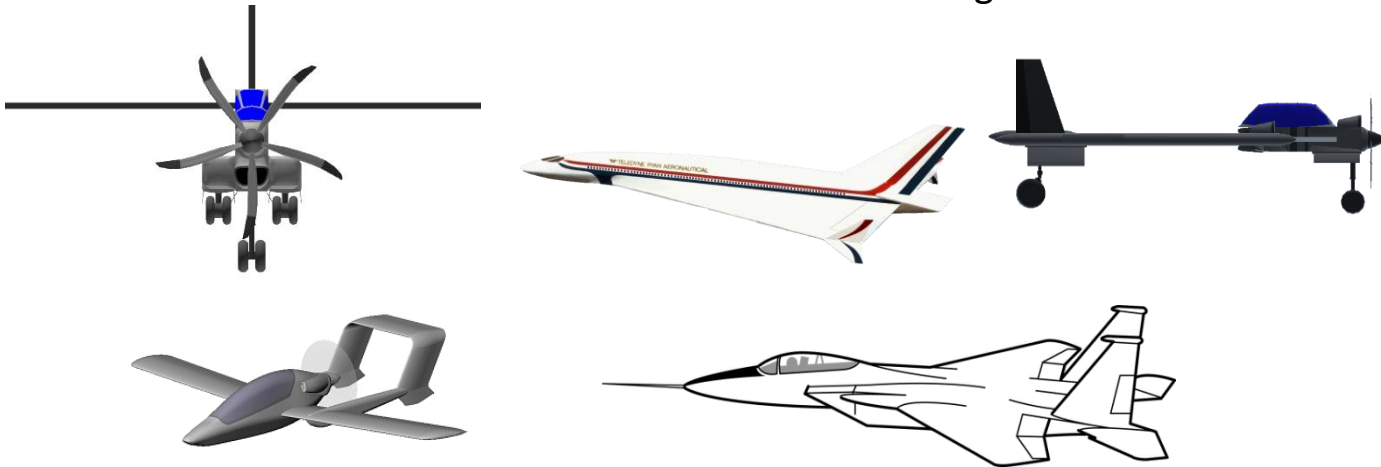
### Optional
