Tasks 1,2 & 5 The Importance Of Getting Help AND What To Say When You Call 999

For these tasks the children will do 3 activities to help them know what to do if someone has an accident, why it's important to get help and what to say to the Emergency Services.

Task 3 Helping Someone Who Is Unconscious

For this task the children will practise putting a patient in the 'Recovery Position' and learn how to open a person's airway.

File names: 03-Unconscious

Task 4 Helping Someone Who Is Bleeding

For this task there are 3 Activities for the children to do. Firstly they will make their Doctors coat using a white t-shirt. Then they will make up their First Aid Kit. And lastly they will treat their patients.
