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Navigator Stage 1 Badge

Overview & Timings

There are **six main** tasks the children need to carry out to complete the 'Navigator Stage 1 Badge'. Below I have outlined roughly what I have created for your children to gain this badge.

Task 1 Locate Yourself On A Simple Map

For this part of the badge you will show the children on a map where your building is located. Then they will go off in teams to pinpoint a point of interest or the road they live in using a map.

File name: 01-Locate Yourself

Task 2 Identify A Number Of Features Or Locations On That Map. You Could Pinpoint Locations Like The Toilets, Car Park, Bird Hide Or Picnic Area

For this part of the badge you the children will locate roads and landmarks on a couple of road maps.

File name: 02-Identify Features On A Map

Task 3 Learn The Four Cardinal Points Of A Compass

For this part of the badge the children will play the 'Compass Game' which will help them remember the points on a compass and where they are.

File name: 03A-Points of Compass

Task 4 Draw A Simple Map Of Where You Live, Your Meeting Place Or Another Area Local To You
