Overview

There are **seven** tasks the children need to perform to complete the 'Emergency Aid Stage 1' Badge. Below I have outlined roughly what I have created for them to complete this badge.

Tasks 1ABC The Importance Of Getting Help AND What To Say When You Call 999

For these tasks the children will do 3 activities to help them know what to do if someone has an accident, why it's important to get help and what to say to the Emergency Services.

File name: 01ABC-Getting Help

Task 2A Helping Someone Who Is Unconscious

For this task the children will practise putting a patient in the 'Recovery Position' and learn how to open a person's airway.

File names: 02A-Unconscious

Task 2BCD Explain How To Help Someone Who: is bleeding, has a burn, is having an asthma attack

The children are going to work within mini hospitals which will have an Accident and Emergency department. You are going to split your group into teams of six. One half of the group are going to be the Accident and Emergency staff and the other half are going to be the patients.
